<b>Description</b>	Team members will take turns drawing representations of a set of scientific terms while other team members guess the term(s) being drawn.
<b>Time Limit</b>	10 minutes per person
<b>Team Size</b>	4 students
<b>Details</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Each team member will have 10 minutes to draw 20 words. The goal is to get your teammates to correctly guess as many words as possible. Each competitor will take a turn drawing with their own stack of 20 words.</li><li>➤ Sketchers are allowed to pass on a word, but cannot go back to it.</li><li>➤ Letters or numbers are not allowed.</li><li>➤ The following symbols are allowed: arrows, minus sign and plus sign. All other symbols are not permitted. Competitors may not use underlines or dashes to show the number of letters in a word.</li><li>➤ Sketchers may not use visual clues with their hands or bodies. This includes nodding and shaking their head.</li><li>➤ If a team violates any of the rules while drawing a word that word will be treated like a pass.</li></ul>
<b>Competition Scoring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ The team that gets the most words correct (adding up all three sketchers scores) will be considered the winner.</li><li>➤ Each team that completes the event successfully (without being disqualified) will earn 10 points. The winning team will earn one bonus point.</li></ul>
